# CMMI Congress 2002

(Council of Mining and Metallurgical Institutions)

## International Codes, Technology and Sustainability for the Minerals Industry

The 2002 CMMI Congress will be a major international event, timed to follow the **Global Mining Initiative ("GMI") Conference**, 12-15 May 2002 in Toronto, Canada, and to immediately precede **Green Processing 2002**, also hosted by The AusIMM, 29-31 May, in Cairns.

The Congress has three themes: 1. International Reporting Standards 2. Mining Technology and Competition 3. Sustainability for the Minerals Industry.

The **Principal Sponsor** will be **Rio Tinto**, and the **Keynote Address** will be delivered by **Leigh Clifford**, Chief Executive of Rio Tinto, who will report on the state of the GMI and the outcome of the Toronto conference.
